ENGLISH FOR HIGH SCHOOL PREPARATION

A highly specialised and structured programme, which develops English skills needed by overseas students including those wishing to continue their education in Australian High Schools. The course is designed to cover reading, writing, listening and speaking with an emphasis on vocabulary for science, maths and studies of society and environment. Students are expected to complete daily homework in addition to research assignments. There is also a compulsory Sports afternoon on Wednesdays. Students **may not** leave the campus during school hours.

REFUND POLICY

- > The Registration fee and Accommodation booking fee and High School Advisory Service are non-refundable.
- > If the required visa is not granted - a full refund of tuition fees will be made, provided that sufficient evidence of visa refusal is given to the college by the refusing Australian Authority.
- > If written cancellation of the enrolment is received 28 days prior to commencement - a full refund of tuition fees will be made.
- > If written cancellation of the enrolment is received less than 28 days prior to commencement - a refund of tuition fees, less a cancellation fee equal to two weeks tuition, will be paid.
- > If written cancellation is received on or within 4 weeks of commencement of a course then the student is entitled to a refund of 30% of the tuition fees, less administrative charges for that semester (20 weeks) and full refund of fees paid in respect of future semesters.
- > No refunds in respect to commencement of any course of duration 10 weeks and under unless provider defaults.
- > Where the College cannot offer the course for which the student has enrolled, or should their VISA application be rejected, the College shall make the necessary refund within 2 weeks.
- > The Colleges dispute resolution processes does not circumscribe the students right to pursue other legal remedies, nor does this agreement remove the right to take further action under Australia consumer protection laws.
- > Should the student cancel their enrolment, the College shall affect the necessary refund within 4 weeks.
- > Provider default is covered by the provisions of the ESOS Act 2000 and ESOS Regulation 2001: **Refunds if the registered provider defaults cannot be covered by a written agreement. Such situations are covered by the provisions of the ESOS Act and the ESOS Regulations 2001.**
